### AN EVALUATION OF VOCABULARY TEACHING

Many children learning English as an additional language (EAL) possess lower levels of English vocabulary knowledge relative to their non-EAL English-speaking peers. Longitudinal work suggests that this group discrepancy does not decrease markedly over time as a result of regular classroom teaching.

### Lesson Plan Self-reflection and Evaluation

Analyze the word for recognizable morphemes, both in the roots and suffixes. Think of a possible meaning based upon the parts of the word. Check the meaning of the word against the context of the reading. Students also need to understand the use of prefixes, suffixes, and roots, and how words get transformed.

### Teaching Morphology: Enhancing Vocabulary Development and ...

Students' vocabulary knowledge is a building process that occurs over time as they make connections to other words, learn examples and nonexamples of the word and related words, and use the word accurately within the context of the sentence (Snow, Griffin, & Burns, 2005).
